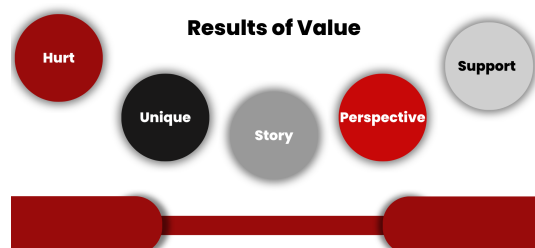
God given Value:
