1.	Scan with copier or Genius Scan or purchase/download ePrint scores
2.	Save to ForScore
3.	Name file and add to setlists
4.	Clean up the score

	b. Crop to maximize and straighten each page
	c. Rearrange pages for repeats, D.C., D.S. etc.
5.	Add Score layer(s) for solfege, interpretation, diction notes. (A score layer allows you to
_	turn on/off for all pages rather than page by page.)
6.	Add solfege, interpretation marks, diction, etc.
	a. When typing solfege, an external keyboard greatly streamlines the process.
7	b. Any stylus or finger will do for writing in the score, but I prefer an Apple Pencil.
